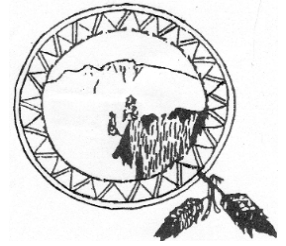


SNOQUALMIE INDIAN TRIBE RESOLUTION #39-2020



Resolution Declaring Tribal State of Emergency Related to COVID-19

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Indian tribe is a sovereign entity recognized as a signatory Tribe to the Point Elliott Treaty of 1855; and

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Tribal Council is the governing body of the Snoqualmie Indian Tribe by the authority of its Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Tribal Council is the duly elected council of the General Membership and is responsible for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the members of the Snoqualmie Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Tribal Council has the authority to regulate its own affairs per the Constitution of the Snoqualmie Tribe of Indians; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1, (o) and Article VIII, Section 2 of the Constitution of Snoqualmie Tribe of Indians, the Snoqualmie Tribal Council has the express and implied powers to adopt laws or resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribe; and

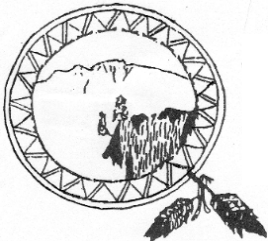
WHEREAS, Art. VIII, Sec. 1(j) of the Constitution of Snoqualmie Tribe of Indians specifically authorizes the Snoqualmie Tribal Council to “safeguard and promote the peace, safety, moral, and general welfare of the members of the Tribe by regulating the behavior of all persons within the jurisdiction of the Tribe, and to provide for the enactment and enforcement of the laws of the Tribe” and Article VIII, Section 2 of the Constitution provides that “[t]he Tribal Council of the Snoqualmie Indian Tribe may exercise such further powers as may reasonably be implied as necessary to carry out any express power as set forth in Section 1 of this Article”; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Washington declared a State of Emergency in response in response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) on February 29, 2020; and

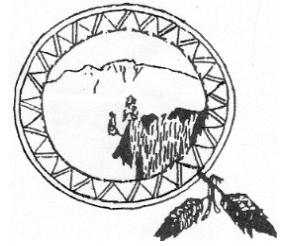
WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Washington issued Proclamation 20-07 on March 11, 2020 limiting public gatherings in King, Pierce and Snohomish Counties; and

WHEREAS, the effects of COVID-19 continue to adversely impact the life and health of Snoqualmie Tribal Members regardless of where they live, as well as the normal operation and function of Tribal offices and Tribal businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Tribal Council has carefully considered the health, safety and general welfare of the Snoqualmie Tribal Community in response to information received from Federal and State Public Health agencies; and

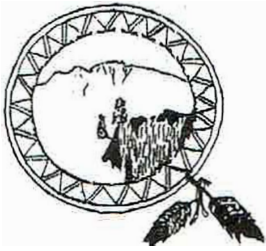

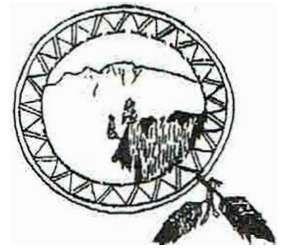
WHEREAS, Tribal Council Act, 10-1, the Snoqualmie Tribe Emergency Management Department, Section 7, provides that, in the event of an emergency or disaster, the Chairman is authorized to, among other things, issue a Tribal emergency proclamation; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, in response to the Washington State of Emergency, the Snoqualmie Tribal Council hereby declares a State of Emergency for the Snoqualmie Indian Tribe until further notice; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the Snoqualmie Tribal Council will continue to monitor this rapidly evolving public health emergency and will take all steps reasonably necessary to protect the health and well-being of Tribal members, Tribal employees, and patrons of Snoqualmie Tribal lands.
