July 10, 2021 Special General Council Meeting

Enclosed you will find a copy of the voting results on the proposed Constitutional Amendments that were considered at the July 10, 2021 Special General Council Meeting. In summary, 12 amendments were voted on, and half (6) passed. A record participation was achieved with 233 enrolled adult Snoqualmie Tribal Members signing in! Of those 233 that signed in, 224 voted with 45 participating via Drive thru and 179 participating via the polls.

All the collected material (note cards/ pamphlets) with suggestions submitted, have been turned over to the Constitution Amendment Committee. If you would like to submit any suggestions related to the 6 amendments that did not pass, please submit them directly to the Constitution Amendment Committee by e-mailing cac@snoqualmietribe.us

The Snoqualmie Tribal Council would like to thank the Constitutional Amendment Committee for their work leading up to this historical vote and thanks them in advance for their continued work.
