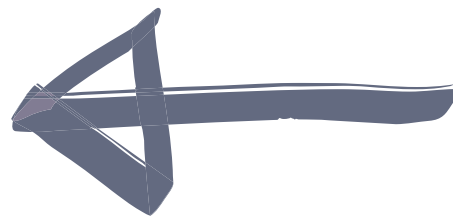
# Support the Tribe!
