



Dear Tribal Member,

The Purchased and Referred Care (PRC) Program is excited to offer PRC Eligibility Cards to eligible Tribal members. The PRC Eligibility Cards will be distributed to Tribal members after their annual renewal process has been completed. The purpose of the eligibility card is to streamline the billing process when paying your medical claims. You will receive further information about the PRC Eligibility Card when your card is issued.

The Tribes PRC program is funded by the Indian Health Service (IHS) and must adhere to IHS and Tribal guidelines. To be eligible for the PRC program you must submit or have on file the following initial documents. Please keep in mind that medical bills that precede your initial application date are not eligible to be covered by this program.

1. Patient Registration Form
2. Proof of Snoqualmie Tribal Enrollment-valid copy of Tribal ID Card or letter of enrollment
3. Birth Certificate(s) for you and your biological minor children
4. Proof of Residency
5. Copy of any medical insurance- if applicable (Private Insurance, other Medicaid, Medicare, Basic Health, Veteran's Administration card)
6. Denial letter from [wahealthplanfinder.org](http://wahealthplanfinder.org)- if applicable. \*If you do not have any medical insurance, Indian Health Services (IHS) requires you to apply for alternate resources.

After the initial application it is required by IHS and Tribal guidelines that the following be submitted on an annual basis:

1. Patient Registration Form
2. Proof of Snoqualmie Tribal Enrollment-valid copy of Tribal ID Card or letter of enrollment (if the card on file has expired)
3. Proof of Residency
4. Copy of any medical insurance- if applicable (Private Insurance, other Medicaid, Medicare, Basic Health, Veteran's Administration card)
5. Denial letter from [wahealthplanfinder.org](http://wahealthplanfinder.org)- if applicable. \*If you do not have any medical insurance, Indian Health Services (IHS) requires you to apply for alternate resources.



For those of you that reside outside the Snoqualmie Tribe's five-county Service Area or PRC Delivery Area (PRCDA), we require the same application requirements as described above. This allows the PRC Program to maintain the "payor of last resort" status so we can extend the Tribe's resources. Please note that if you qualify for a state plan or have primary insurance, in order for your bills to be covered by the PRC program, your services must be at rendered at a place that is in-network with your insurance carrier. The insurance carrier and provider must be willing to work with the PRC programs' billing department. The insurance carrier must pay their portion of the bill *before* the PRC program can pay the remaining balance.

We have enclosed the PRC Tribal Benefits Guide for your review. The fiscal year benefit amounts for dental, dentures and orthodontics have been combined into one Dental Care category. This update will allow the flexibility for you to utilize the funding for your individual dental care needs.

Benefits per Fiscal Year October 1st through September 30th

**ELDERS LIMITS PER FISCAL YEAR**

- Glasses/Contacts-\$700
- Dental Care-\$13,000 (includes dental, dentures and orthodontics)
- Hearing Aids-\$5,000

The PRC program may also cover co-pays and deductibles on medical services.

**LIMITS PER FISCAL YEAR**

- Glasses/Contacts-\$600
- Dental Care-\$13,000 (includes dental, dentures and orthodontics)
- Hearing Aids-\$5,000

The PRC program may also cover co-pays and deductibles on medical services.

If your insurance does not provide the following services, you may be eligible through Purchase Referred Care (PRC) for:

- Chiropractic Visits
- Acupuncture Visits
- Outpatient Rehab
- Occupational Therapy
- Speech Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- Massage Therapy

Please contact the Purchase Referred Care Team for your benefit eligibility.

Purchase Referred Care (PRC) does not cover the following items:

- Collection Fees
- No Show/Cancelation Fees
- Interest Fees
- Late Fees
- Services provided prior to PRC eligibility

Please remember budgets are funded yearly and amounts are subject to change due to federal funding.

**PLEASE REMEMBER TO:**

- Purchase Referred Care is required to have an annual renewal to determine service eligibility.
- Purchase Referred Care (PRC) Team BEFORE seeing your provider with the date of your appointment, name of provider and whether it's a medical, dental or vision appointment. Once your request has been processed a purchase order will be generated.
- The purchase order is your pre-authorization. Without a pre-authorization payment cannot be guaranteed.
