ELIGIBILITY:

All eligible applicants must provide in the application the school's name, student's name and provide proof attendance for the coming year..

- **Higher Education or (AVT)** students must be enrolled in a degree program, taking a minimum of one class toward their degree program or certificate program, and be earning a minimum **2.0 GPA**.
- **Scholarship Higher Education or (AVT)-** students must be enrolled in a degree program, taking a minimum of one class toward their degree program or certificate program, and be earning a minimum **2.0 GPA**.

BENEFIT AMOUNTS:

Eligible applicants are able to receive \$175 to be used towards clothing, fees, parking, books, technology, and required school supplies.

BENEFIT DISTRIBUTION:

Upon receipt of a completed application, a check will be issued within 14 business days. The last day to apply for the benefit is February 28, 2022. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to maintain proper records of invoices, receipts, and payments made toward eligible clothing and school supply expenses. Receipts for this program must be dated between February 1, 2022 and April 30, 2022.

AGREEMENT STATEMENT:

This program is intended to fall under the Tribe's General Welfare Policy. It is the intent of the Tribal Council that the Program be funded from the Tribe's general fund, and that Services provided by the Program will not be subject to state or federal taxation and will not reduce fixed income or other benefits of the recipients. However, recipients should consult with their own tax and/or legal professionals to determine actual tax and benefit consequences.

The recipient understands repayment may be required from the recipient if the Tribe deems the funds to have been misused. The Tribe may pursue any available remedies at law and/or equity to recover misused funds. Under Federal Tax Rules, benefit payment that is not used for the purposes provided for in this Policy will be treated as taxable income by the IRS. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to maintain proper records of invoices, receipts, and payments made toward eligible clothing and school supply expenses.

I certify the information contained in this application is complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge. I understand that I am signing this application and if I knowingly give false information which results in payment to which I am not entitled I will be required to return the funds.
