



ANNOUNCEMENT OF REGISTRATION OPENING ON SEPTEMBER 6

Snoqualmie Indian Tribe and Bright Horizons are excited to announce registration will open on **Tuesday, September 6th** for the new Snoqualmie Indian Tribe Child Development Center, which is anticipated to open in early 2023 at 9575 Ethan Wade Way SE. The initial registration period will remain open through **Friday, September 30th**. To begin the registration process for the new center, visit Bright Horizons' [Family Information Center](#) to establish an account (please see attached document for helpful tips on how to set up an account). The registration fee is \$150 per family, payable at the time of registration.

Families Applying for CCDF Grant Program

The Tribe operates the Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) grant to assist Native families with access to high quality child care and early learning opportunities. The CCDF grant can assist eligible Native families with registration fee assistance and monthly subsidized tuition. To apply for grant funding please fill out a CCDF application from the Tribe's website under General Benefits or email childcare@snoqualmietribe.us for a copy, prior to registering with Bright Horizons.

In October, initial interest for all age groups will be assessed, and enrollment spaces will be allocated based on the following priority grouping:

- Priority 1 – Native Families (must have a parent enrolled in a U.S. Federally recognized Tribe)
- Priority 2 – Children of Employees of the Snoqualmie Tribe, Crescent Market, Snoqualmie Casino, Eighth Generation, and Salish Lodge & Spa
- Priority 3 – Snoqualmie Valley Community at large

All families will receive an enrollment update mid-October informing you of your enrollment status. Families will still be able to register for enrollment consideration after September 30th, but enrollment offers for the center opening will be prioritized based on registration date and requested start dates, following the priority groupings.
